



Opportunistic Salpingectomy

For patients who have completed childbearing, we offer opportunistic salpingectomies at the time of cesarean section. We remove the fallopian tubes at the time of cesarean section which only adds about 10 minutes to the procedure itself and does not change the recovery from the cesarean alone.

In addition to preventing future pregnancies, there is evidence that removing the fallopian tubes reduces the lifetime risk of ovarian cancer. This does not affect hormone levels.
